# **Welcome to Kids Club: Summer 2019**

As summer quickly approaches, parents scramble to find “stuff” for their school-aged child to do!

At Siblings & Company, we provide a 12-week program filled with activities and field trips that will keep your child engaged and active!

The information in this booklet is a limited view into the summer program!

## **1. Thank you for your interest in our program!**

We welcome the challenge of designing and implementing a program that will be of interest to the children, exciting for them, and help them remain strong in mind and body throughout the summer months.

## **2. Let me take a minute to explain the organization of the summer program.**

1. There are 12 weeks throughout the summer (10 regular weeks and 2 holiday weeks.)
2. Each full week has a theme/focus that allows the teachers to work their magic on projects, activities, and excursions.
3. The summer can be purchased in packages that consist of a predetermined number of weeks. If you choose the 10-week package, we will be asking that you give us the weeks that your child will not be attending. These weeks are tuition free for your school age child!
4. The available weekly packages are listed on the next page with the field trip cost associated with your package. Field trip costs include trip admission, extra staff required, and transportation costs.

## **3. Fundraising is available to help with the cost of Field Trips Costs.**

More information is found inside this packet! This is optional.

**4. Shirts and Lunches.** We will continue with the colored coordinated Siblings and Co shirts for field trip and park days. If you have yours from last year, you may use it again if it still fits. Otherwise, we will be placing an order for anyone who needs to purchase another one. They will be \$8.00/shirt.

Friday park days will be optional “pack your own lunch” days. Children will have the choice to bring their own lunchbox that day. Lunches must be peanut free as we do have an allergy. We will provide lunch for anyone who chooses not to bring one.

If you are utilizing the part time option, then talk to your director about your field trip costs.

The Field Trip Package is a one-time charge and it will cover all of the trips for the whole summer including weekly excursions, pool days, transportation expenses and additional staff for safety at water activities. If a trip is canceled due to weather, it will be rescheduled if possible or an alternate trip will take its place. If your child is unable to attend the trip for any reason, the package price does remain the same.

### **There are 2 payment options for the Field Trip Package:**

One time payment of the full Field Trip Package due on Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup> OR Divide package in half for 2 installments due May 17<sup>th</sup> and June 14<sup>th</sup>.

Field Trip payments cannot be made through venmo unfortunately. They will need to be check or cash.

If you participate in the optional fundraiser, your profit earned will be deducted from your Field Trip Cost.

We have so many great adventures lined up for this summer, but unfortunately, they add up financially! In order to help with this, we provide the opportunity to participate in a fundraiser where the profit will go towards trip expenses.

The fundraiser is OPTIONAL and all profit from your individual sales will be put towards your child's summer trip expenses. Again, this is an individual fundraiser, not class wide. If you sell more than what your trips require, the remainder will go towards a special treat for the class. Ex: Ice cream day, pizza for lunch, etc.

**Your child will receive 40% of their total sales and it will be deducted from their field trip amount.**

## *Frequently Asked Questions*

### **Is it possible to volunteer for a trip?**

Absolutely! We would love to have family involvement and welcome volunteers on any trip☺ If there is room on the bus, you can ride along!

### **If my child does not attend the field trip when they were supposed to, do I still have to pay for that trip?**

The field trip packages are all inclusive and if your child misses a trip because of illness or absence, the same rates will apply. If a child is asked to not participate because of behavior in the classroom, payments will be discussed.

### **If my child wishes to not participate in a field trip and wants to stay behind, what will happen?**

Your child can attend before or after the trip but alternate arrangements must be made while the class is on the trip.

### **What happens if I leave for the summer but would like to return once school resumes?**

Your child will be put at the top of the waiting list if there is room after the summer months. Unfortunately, the enrollment spot cannot be held for the next school year if the child does not attend throughout the summer.

### **What do the field trip packages include and why do they have to be paid up front?**

The teachers used to keep track of all the expenses and money for the field trips each week and this created responsibilities that the teachers shouldn't have to worry about. Siblings will be writing the checks for each trip rather than the teachers having to carry all of the cash.

The packages include all trip admission fees, extra staffing per DCFS guidelines, swim day admission and transportation fees.

### **Depending on the school district, the first and last week of the summer program may include school days. How will tuition be applied those weeks?**

The last and first week of school will be charged as a regular "school year" week with the additional charges added if your child is present on the days before school is back in session. The summer rates will begin on May 27<sup>th</sup>.

### **Are the trip dates set in stone?**

Yes and No. All of the trips have been confirmed but it is possible for them to change due to transportation, staff or weather issues. We do try to stick to the schedule as much as we can.
