# Siblings & Co. Families Covid Exposure: What do we do?

All policies below are subject to change. Last Update: December 2022

If your child starts showing symptoms, it is your choice to test for Covid. If you choose not to test for Covid, we will refer to our DCFS policies on when your child can return for their specific symptoms. We just ask that you use your judgement on what is best for your child and the class.

## I. Household Member Tests Positive

At this time, if someone in your house is showing symptoms (not the child enrolled) it is your decision if you choose to test or not. Nothing is required on our end. If you decide to test and it is positive, that's when your child will also be advised to quarantine for 5 days and can return if they are not showing any symptoms on the 6<sup>th</sup> day.

### II. Child Enrolled Tests Positive

If your child enrolled starts showing symptoms and you decide to test them and they are positive, quarantine can be 5 or 10 days, depending on their symptoms and age. You can ask your doctor or Health Department about a return date.

If you have more than one child enrolled, the siblings is not required to quarantine but wouldn't be a terrible idea.

#### III. Tuition Due

Waivers for Covid are no longer available.

## IV. Positive in my child's class?

If someone tests positive in your child's class, we will post a note outside of the classroom stating there is a positive case. You may choose to quarantine your child but are not required to, however tuition remains normal.
